Of all the islands around Britain, the Isle of Wight is one of the most interesting to visit with its mild climate, historic houses, pretty villages and wealth of wildlife including red squirrels and white tailed eagles. Next May we shall be staying at the 3-star **Brunswick Hotel** which overlooks the sea on the southern side of the island at **Shanklin**. It has a lovely garden, panoramic sea views and indoor and outdoor pools.

ITINERARY

Day 1 (Friday) We set off from West London and travel south westwards to a 4-star hotel in Hampshire where we shall have coffee. Next our Bessway coach will drive onto a Red Funnel ferry at Southampton for our crossing of the Solent to **East Cowes**. In the afternoon we visit Queen Victoria's favourite home **Osborne House**, a large impressive mansion in the Italianate style with a stunning interior and colourful gardens. Finally we shall check-in at the **Brunswick Hotel** at **Shanklin** for our 3-night stay. **Dinner** here this evening.

Day 2 (Saturday) After breakfast we plan to visit the important **Botanic Garden** at **Ventnor** prior to taking a scenic drive along the coast road towards **The Needles**. This afternoon we shall pass through **Freshwater** before arriving at **Yarmouth** where there will be time to explore this attractive town with its wealth of old buildings. **Dinner** at our hotel.


Day 3 (Sunday) Morning at leisure in **Shanklin** with its beach, chine and pleasant walks. An afternoon visit to the enchanting and colourful **Mottistone Gardens** (National Trust). **Dinner** at our hotel.

Day 4 (Monday) Our final day will see us taking a morning drive through Sandown to Bembridge and Brading before we stop at the **Donkey Sanctuary**. Then via Godshill to the historic **Carisbrooke Castle** where Charles I was held prisoner during the Civil War. Finally we shall return to Southampton in the mid afternoon aboard the Red Funnel ferry. At 6.00pm **Dinner** awaits us at the impressive **Tyley Hall Hotel** near Hook in Hampshire.




