Tenby and the Brecon Beacons

Sunday 6 June 2021 for 4 days

Our short break to South West Wales in 2019 was certainly well received and enjoyed not least because of the wonderful scenery we experienced. This time, apart from paying a return visit to the charming seaside resort of **Tenby**, we shall be featuring the majestic **Brecon Beacons National Park** and taking you to the impressive **National Botanic Garden of Wales** which is near Carmarthen. Once again we shall be staying at the well appointed 4-star **Stradey Park Hotel & Spa**, Llanelli, which looked after us very well last time.

ITINERARY

Day 1 (Sunday) Marlborough Cardiff Swansea Bay

We shall depart West London (Shepherds Bush, Ealing, Greenford, Hillingdon etc) and travel westwards to **Marlborough** where we shall stop for **morning coffee**. We shall then continue our journey by travelling over the Severn Bridge into Wales. **Lunch** will be near the attractive waterfront in **Cardiff**. Our route will then take us via **Swansea** with its lovely views of Swansea Bay prior to us arriving at the **Stradey Park Hotel and Spa at Llanelli** where we shall stay for 3 nights. **Dinner** at our hotel this evening.

Day 2 (Monday) Tenby and Caldey Island

After breakfast our coach will travel westwards to **Tenby**, a delightful seaside resort dating from the 13th century. The old town walls still stand and the picturesque little harbour is surrounded by quaint Georgian houses. We shall stay here until 5pm thereby allowing everyone time to take an optional 20-minute boat trip, if they wish, to nearby **Caldey Island** where the cistercian monks live, work and pray. There are shops in the village as well as the abbey church where there is a viewing gallery. **Dinner** at our hotel.

Day 3 (Tuesday) The Gower Coast and the National Botanic Garden

We shall set off this morning for a visit to **Rhossili Bay**, scenically one of the finest places on the spectacular Gower Peninsula. Subsequently we plan to take you to the **National Botanic Garden of Wales** with its enormous single span glasshouse, 360ft long and 200ft wide. Thousands of plant species grow here in a Mediterranean climate, many of them quite rare. Prior to **Dinner** at our hotel this evening we plan to have a recital of music played on the harp.

Day 4 (Wednesday) The Brecon Beacons National Park

Our homeward journey will see us travelling via the scenery of the Brecon Beacons. A trip on the **Brecon Beacons Mountain Railway** will be included followed by a stop in the market town of **Brecon** where you will be able to obtain a lunchtime snack. A stop for a **2-course dinner** will be made near Gloucester at 6.00pm. Traffic permitting we expect to be back in West London by 9.30pm at Hillingdon, slightly later at our other set-down points.

NB: As on all short breaks, our **home pick-up service** will be available (for a small extra charge) to return you to your home from the first of our coach setting-down points at Hillingdon Station. This service is also available at the commencement of the tour to collect you from your home and bring you to Hillingdon to board our coach there. The charge is £7 per person each way.

How to Book

A deposit of **£80 per person** will secure your place on this tour.
